**Pumpkin Scotchies**

- 1 1/2 cup canned 100% pure pumpkin
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup butterscotch chips
- 1 cup chopped walnuts

Preheat the oven to 350 degree F. Coat baking sheets with cooking spray.

In a large bowl, combine the pumpkin, sugar, and vanilla; add remaining ingredients and mix well.

Drop by teaspoonful onto prepared baking sheets.

Bake 12 to 15 minutes or until golden.
